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- ❖ **Great Smoky Mountain**
Great Smoky Mountains National Park is a United States National Park and UNESCO World Heritage Site that straddles the ridgeline of the Great Smoky Mountains, part of the Blue Ridge Mountains, which are a division of the larger Appalachian Mountain chain.
- ❖ **Dixie Stampede**
This Wild-West-Revue-type performance features animals such as pigs, horses, and chickens and is punctuated by a riding competition. The show starts an hour before dinner, with a musical act on the "Carriage Room" before guests are escorted into the arena.

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❖ Titanic Museum Pigeon Forge

The Titanic Museum is a two-story museum shaped like the RMS Titanic. It is located in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee and opened on April 8, 2010. It is built half-scale to the original ship. Similar to the one in Branson, Missouri, the museum holds 400 pre-discovery artifacts in twenty galleries. It is the largest permanent Titanic museum in the world.

❖ Helen Town

Helen town started as a home to the Cherokee, and then to European settlers who came for the gold and the timber. It's known for its vineyards and Bavarian-style buildings. It's the charm of Bavaria, in the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains.
