Itinerary

Day 1 Atlanta – Charlotte (12/27 Thursday)
 Hotel : Quality Inn Christiansburg, / Quality Inn Roanoke Airport or equivalent

In the morning, we will head for Charlotte, which is the largest city in North Carolina. Charlotte is home to the corporate headquarters of Bank of America and the east coast operations of Wells Fargo, which along with other financial institutions made it the second-largest banking center in the United States from 1995 to 2017 and the third-largest from 2017 to present.

In Charlotte, we will visit **NASCAR hall of Fame** (60 minutes), it wasn't just built to be a museum. It was built to be a shrine to the history, heritage, and future of the sport we love. And then we will stop by City Hall, bank of America headquarters.

Day 2

Luray Caverns – Washington D.C. (12/28 Friday)

Hotel : Days Inn/Quality Inn/Comfort Inn or equivalent

Our first destination will be the natural wonder **Luray Caverns** (60 mins) in the morning, Luray Caverns is the largest underground Millennium Stalactite cave in North America, formed over 4 billion years ago. Discovered in 1878. Every year more than a few million tourists make Luray Cave become the most popular cave in East America. As early as 130 years ago, this cave is known throughout the United States as one of the most spectacular natural caves in the world and is praised as “Stone Wonderland”. The cave is very large, and there are many mysterious caves. There are countless stalactites in the cave. Or large or small, or fat or thin, or standing or lying, blending and forming a wonderful, amazing natural landscape.

In the afternoon, we will head to Washington D.C., and visit the **Madame Tussands** (60 mins) in Washington D.C. which is the only attraction you can get close to the “44 presidents” of US. We will have the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House, taking photographs with Oval Office desk aka The Resolute Desk. The great names will be memorized and honored forever.

Next, we will visit the **White House** (exterior, 15 mins, reverse side of \$20 Bill). We will also visit the U.S. Department of Treasury (exterior, reverse side of \$10 Bill), **Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial and Vietnam War Memorial (45 mins)**. Lincoln Memorial (reverse side of \$5 Bill) is built in recognition of the great efforts of President Abraham Lincoln for American human rights, and the famous speech “I Have a Dream” by Martin Luther King Jr. take place right outside Lincoln Memorial.(Due to effect of early sunset during winter time, we will visit Lincoln Memorial after dusk.)

Day 3

Washington D.C. – Philadelphia (12/29 Saturday)

Hotel : Days Hotel East Brunswick, Red Roof Inn Edison or equivalent

Depart from the hotel in early morning, we will first visit the **US Capitol (120 mins)** (reverse side of \$50 bill). The U.S. Capitol was established at 1793, it has become the symbol of American people and government. Our professional tour guide will bring you inside the Capitol building and have a look around the interior of the Capitol building (if the Capitol is closed, we will visit the exterior of the Capitol building instead.) We will also visit the Library of Congress (exterior), which has served the United States congress for more than 200 years, and Supreme Court of the United States (exterior). After that, we will take the **D.C. Cruise** (60 mins) along Potomac River to see many of the areas’ most historic landmarks and memorials in a unique way.

Then we will head to the **National Independence Historical Park** (30 mins) in Philadelphia. While walking on the cobblestone streets, it seems that you could still hear the rings by the Liberty Bell, which has witnessed the founding history of America. Independence Hall (exterior, reverse side of \$100 bill), is

the birthplace of American modern democracy, where the Declaration of the Independence and the Constitution was debated and adopted.

Next, we will visit **One Liberty Observation Deck** (60 mins), which is the only observation deck in Philadelphia. Guests will stand on the shoulder of Philadelphia's 'giant', Benjamin Franklin, to see the historic city through a splendid 360-degree view.

Day 4

New York City Tour (12/30 Sunday)

At a first glance, travelling around the entire of New York City seems like the mission impossible; however, our highly organized tour is an especially designed for you: by visiting amounts of famous landmarks, you will learn more about the city's unique history, culture, and the core spirit of the New Yorkers! By stepping up to **the Empire State Building Observation deck (70 mins)**, guests could overlook the beautiful view of the central park and the entire of New York City. Empire State Building stood as the world's tallest building for nearly 40 years and has surpassed in late 1970. Its name has derived from the nickname of New York, the Empire State. Nowadays it is still the most famed landmark of the city. In addition, Guests will take a **sightseeing cruise (60 mins)** tour on the Hudson River to enjoy the city view from a completely different angle, as well as take pictures with the backdrops of Statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. Furthermore, visit **U.S.S INTREPID (90 mins)**, the national heritage that costs \$120 million, which is reopen for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be in the exhibition. In addition, wandering around the world's famous financial and securities trading center – **Wall Street**, taking pictures with the New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture **Charging Bull**, and visiting Trinity Church, **Times Square (20 mins)**. Of course, we cannot miss the renowned **Metropolitan Museum of Art (120 mins)**. The Metropolitan Museum of Art is the largest art museum in the United States with more than 2 million works of art collection. In the end of the day, our tour bus will pass by the Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, Ground Zero and the new "Freedom tower", One World Trade Center. Certainly, Broadway musicals are one of the most celebrated symbols of the city. You will have a chance to watch the world class Broadway shows of opening after 7:00PM upon your request. (Note: the admission is on your own expense, and you can book tickets from tour guide in advance owing to seats are limited.) (If you book the Broadway show tickets with us, we will provide \$100 drop-off service for free!)

Day 5

New York Times Square Countdown (12/31 Monday)

Hotel : Days Hotel East Brunswick, Red Roof Inn Edison or equivalent

In the morning, we will visit the Central Park of New York and the 5th Ave. You may enjoy Lady M or Luke's Lobster for brunch. We will pass by Trump Tower, Apple Flagship store, and much more high-end brands on 5th Ave (There would be no space for storage shopping bags so please do not purchase any goods on that day). Next, we are heading to the Times Square countdown area, and celebrating New Year with thousands of visitors.

You will have 3 options for the countdown:

1. **You may walk to Times Square and watch performances before the countdown.** At the same time, the countdown zone will be closed for pedestrians only; you may experience the world-famous New Year street celebrations to witness the historic moment. **(Free of charge)**
