# ITINERARY

## Day 1: Home – New York (Tuesday 12/25)

Hotel: Hilton East Brunswick

**The first day itinerary is for your reference only; the schedule is subject to change upon your arrival.**

Thanks for choosing your vacation with us! You can choose any one of the major airports in New York City (JFK, LGA, EWR) when you book your flight. Our professional tour guide will meet you at the baggage claim area for the domestic flight; for international flight, please arrive at the Passenger Waiting Area for pick up. (Passengers, who arrive at Terminal 7 of JFK Airport, please wait outside of the baggage claim area.)

1. Guests who arrive at JFK or LGA airport before 5:00pm will be sent to Flushing Queens. We will provide free luggage storage service, and our guests can visit nearby Queens Crossing, Macy's Shopping Center. In addition, Flushing is a safe and booming Asian commercial and retail area with many shopping and dining options. You will experience the distinctive Asian-American culture.
2. For those who arrive at EWR airport, feel free to take our shuttle to Jersey Garden Outlet and we will take you back to the hotel as soon as the rooms are ready to check-in.

### New York Morning Tour

- For guests who meet tour guide before 9:00AM in JFK or LGA airport, guests can join morning tour.
- Book advanced before landing can enjoy promotion price: \$1/person (Seats guaranteed. If passengers couldn't meet the tour guide before 9:00AM because of flights delay or personal reasons, \$1 will be returned). Join the morning tour on arriving day (Seats limited): \$25/adult and \$15/child. (Complimentary transfer excludes service fee \$10/per person)
- **Itinerary: DUMBO (20 mins) → Madison Square & Flatiron Building (Outside view, 20 mins) → Washington Square & New York University (Outside view, 15 mins)**

**DUMBO** is a neighborhood in the New York City borough of Brooklyn. On December 18, 2007, the New York City Landmarks Preservation Commission voted unanimously to designate Dumbo as the city's 90th historic district.

**The Flatiron building** has been called "one of the world's most iconic skyscrapers and a quintessential symbol of New York City", anchors the south (downtown) end of Madison Square and the north (uptown) end of the Ladies' Mile Historic District. The neighborhood around it is called the Flatiron District after its signature building, which has become an icon of New York City.

**Washington Square Park** is an open space, dominated by the Washington Square Arch at the northern gateway to the park, with a tradition of celebrating nonconformity. The park's fountain area has long been one of the city's popular spots for residents and tourists. Most of the buildings surrounding the park now belong to New York University.

### New York Night Tour

- All guests who arrive before 4:30PM can join our tailored night tour to experience the charm of "the city that never sleeps"
- Price: \$25/adult and \$15/child. (Complimentary transfer excludes service fee \$10/per person)
- **Itinerary: Rockefeller Center (15 mins) → Times Square (30 mins) → An observation point in NJ (15 mins)**

**Rockefeller Center** is described as one of the greatest projects of the Great Depression era, Rockefeller Center was declared a New York City landmark in 1985 and a National Historic Landmark in 1987.

**Times Square** is a major commercial intersection, tourist destination, entertainment center and neighborhood. One of the world's busiest pedestrian areas. And it's very charming at night.

**Great observation point in NJ**, high up on the cliffs overlooking the Hudson River. There, you will enjoy what is considered to be the best night view of the New York City skyline.

## **Day 2: New York (Wednesday 12/26)**

Hotel: Hilton East Brunswick

We will go to the Wall Street financial district (30mins), taking photos with the Trinity Church, the Federal Hall, New York Stock Exchange, and the Charging Bull. Next we will head to the Empire State Building (60mins), which stood as the world's tallest skyscraper for nearly 40 years. The observation of Empire State gives a panoramic view of New York City. Moreover, we will take the Statue of Liberty Sightseeing Cruise (60mins), seeing the symbol of US "Liberty" while enjoying the view of Hudson River. We will also visit the "Crossroads of the world" Time Square (30mins) to experience the heart of world's entertainment industry. Next we will go for Gulliver's Gate (50mins). Leave the Land of Large and enter an amazing new experience, located at the crossroads of the world, Times Square. Of course, we will not miss the opportunity to visit the Metropolitan Museum of Art (100mins). Thousands of the collections will make your trip worth going. Furthermore, visiting U.S.S Intrepid (60mins), the national heritage that costs \$120 million, this is reopening for visitors. Concorde supersonic airliner and a variety of aircrafts will be in the exhibition. Certainly, Broadway musicals are one of the most celebrated symbols of the city. You will have a chance to watch the world-class Broadway shows upon your request. (Note: the admission is on your own expense, and you can book tickets from tour guide in advance owing to seats are limited.) (If you book the Broadway show tickets with us, we will provide \$100 drop-off service for free!)

## **Day 3: New York – Princeton – Hershey's Chocolate World– Christmas Village (Thursday 12/27)**

Hotel: Hilton Harrisburg

In the morning, we will visit Princeton University (60 mins), one of the prestigious Ivy League schools in United States. Princeton University is a vibrant community of scholarship and learning that stands in the nation's service and in the service of humanity. A guided campus tour will be arranged after arrival, it will give us the best opportunity to know more about this prestigious institution.

Next we will head to the Hershey's Chocolate World in Pennsylvania. Treat yourself to an assortment of one-of-kind experiences and discover the sweetest feeling of pure happiness. Follow cocoa beans on a delicious journey in an immersive chocolate making tour (30mins). See, feel, hear and smell the transformation of cocoa beans to Hershey's famous chocolate on this fun tour.

Our next stop is the Christmas Village (60mins), celebrating its 69 years of season's greetings. Driving through the darkened countryside and coming over that last hill on the unlit country road is like driving into a fairyland. Suddenly you find yourself in a dazzling valley set aglow with more than one million Christmas lights adorning buildings, gift barns, and landscape. A reflective lake adds to the stunning beauty of this magical place.

## **Day 4: Washington DC (Friday 12/28)**

**Hotel: Hilton Washington-Dulles Intl Airport/ Hilton Gaithersburg**

Will head to Washington DC in the morning and begin our day by visiting the U.S. Capitol (90mins)—the temple of liberty. (If the Capitol is closed, we will see the exterior) We will take the National Ferry Cruise (60mins) on Potomac River. Enjoy the view of the Pentagon, Air Force Memorial, Fort McNair Officers Club and Titanic Memorial etc. Next we are going to visit the most famous resident in the United State – White House (30mins), the official residence and workplace of the President of the United States. At holiday season, we also have the opportunity to witness the National Christmas Tree on the Ellipse. The tradition of the National Christmas Tree began with President Calvin Coolidge over 90 years ago. Today the tradition continues and is one of the most beloved holiday events in Washington DC. Next we will visit the Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial and Vietnam War Memorial (45mins). The International Spy Museum (60mins) is a museum exploring the craft, practice, history, and contemporary role of espionage. It is the only public museum in the United States solely dedicated to espionage and the only one in the world to provide a global perspective on an all-but-invisible profession. We will be visiting the Madame Tussauds in Washington D.C. (60mins) which is the only attraction you can get close to the “45 presidents” of US. We will have the chance to explore the inner structure of The White House, taking photographs with Oval Office desk aka The Resolute Desk. The great names will be memorized and honored forever.

## **Day 5: Busch Garden – Virginia Beach (Saturday 12/29)**

**Hotel: Wyndham Virginia Beach Oceanfront**

We will spend the afternoon in Busch Garden (240mins) Williamsburg in Virginia. Fun is always in season at Busch Gardens. Christmas Town is the park's Christmas event that began during the 2009 season. Several Christmas and holiday themed attractions and shows are showcased, including a 50-foot (15 m) animated Christmas tree called "O Tannenbaum" that lights up in sync to Christmas music in the Oktoberfest portion of the park.

In the evening, we will arrive at the Virginia Beach and enjoy the miles of beaches and hundreds of hotels and restaurants along the oceanfront. The Guinness Book of World Records has awarded Virginia Beach the title of "Longest Pleasure Beach." Here, 35 miles of coastline waiting for you to explore. You will also find a 3-mile long concrete path that guides you through 59 blocks of popular statues, stages for music and entertainment, shops, restaurants, hotels, and gorgeous views of the Atlantic Ocean. It's so easy to relax when you're sitting or lying in the warm sand by the gentle yet powerful lapping waves of the Atlantic. Enjoy swimming in the warm ocean and experience the health benefits of the salt water and other healthy minerals you'll absorb at the Virginia Beach oceanfront.

## **Day 6: Delaware – Philadelphia (Sunday 12/30)**

**Hotel: Hilton East Brunswick**

In the morning, we will head to the First State – Delaware, it is known by this nickname due to the fact that on December 7, 1787, and it became the first of the 13 original states to ratify the U.S. Constitution. We will go to the Christiana Mall (120mins), which provides tax-free shopping with brand-name stores and is conveniently. You can enjoy shopping tax-free at the Christiana Mall stores including Apple, Microsoft, Nordstrom, Cabela's, Michael Kors plus, much more.

Next, we will head to the National Independence Historical Park in Philadelphia (40mins). While walking on the cobblestone streets, it seems that you could still hear the rings by the Liberty Bell, which has witnessed the founding history of America. We will also visit the Independence Hall (outside view), the birthplace of American modern democracy, where the Declaration of the Independence and the Constitution was debated and adopted.

## Day 7: New York Times Square Countdown (Monday 12/31)

Hotel: Hilton East Brunswick

In the morning, we will visit the Central Park of New York and the 5th Ave. You may enjoy Lady M or Luke's Lobster for brunch. We will pass by Trump Tower, Apple Flagship store, and much more high-end brands on 5th Ave (There would be no space for storage shopping bags so please do not purchase any goods on that day). When the clock strikes midnight, make a toast and turn your head to the sky for a brilliant firework display that illuminates iconic landmarks and adds splashes of color to the skyline. **(\$411/person, including transfer service to the pier)**

After the countdown, guests can choose to return to the hotel and rest or use a free drop-off service directly to the three major airports (LGA / JFK / EWR), taking flights after 4:00 AM on 1 January 2019. If the room is not occupied at that night (count by room), Tour fee does not change; If room is occupying, and drop-off service is provided for guests who shared the room, there will be a one-time charge of \$20/person, please inform your tour leader in advance.
