Princeton University

Independence National Historical Park

The memorial is located by the Tidal Basin, from where you will have a stunning view of the Cherry Blossom blooming along the shore during the time. Later you will have a chance to take the D.C. Cherry Blossom Cruise for sightseeing along the Potomac River. With a backdrop of full blooming cherry trees on the banks of the Potomac River, you can also see the most iconic landmarks in the area.

Itinerary:

U.S. Capitol (Inside Visit, 90 mins) → Library of Congress (Outside Visit) → Supreme Court of the United States (Outside Visit) → Newseum (Optional, 60 mins) → Jefferson Memorial (30 mins) → D.C. Cherry Blossom Cruise (Optional, 60 mins)

We will also pass by The World War II Memorial.

Special Notes:

1. If U.S. Capitol closed to visitors, we will see the exterior of the building from outside. The Capitol Visitor Center is open to visitors from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday except for Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day and on Inauguration Day.
2. Each year, the National Cherry Blossom Festival celebrates spring in Washington, DC. As for this year, the official schedule is March 20 - April 13. However, the view of the cherry blossom is subject to change due to weather conditions. Furthermore, reservation is not available for the Cherry Blossom Cruise based on the busy season in D.C.
3. The cruise tour is subject to change regarding the cruise company's schedule as well as the tourist volume. In case that cruise was not in service, we will go to the renowned Madame Tussauds' President Gallery instead.
