Day 1

New York – ICE! @ National Harbor

Hotel : Quality Inn/Days Inn or equivalent

Departure from New York City in the morning, our tour begins by traveling through the beautiful scenery from New York down to North Carolina.

Day 2

South of the Border (Carolina)-Savannah, Georgia

Continuing our tour down to the South on day 2, we will pass through South of the Border and Savannah, Georgia.

South of the Border is a rest stop and roadside attraction between Dillon, South Carolina and Rowland, North Carolina. Its Mexican themed kitsch location has served as a rest stop for tourist traveling to and from Florida since 1950s. Its mascot is Pedro, an extravagantly stereotypical Mexican bandito.

Savannah is the oldest city in the State of Georgia. Its unique architecture and historic buildings have attracted millions of visitors. Its beautiful scenery also can be seen from the movie "Forest Gump". Its favorite stories involve the life of Florence Martus, who was known by Savannahinas and sailors of the sea as "the Waving Girl". Florence Martus took it upon herself to be the unofficial greeter of all ships that entered and left the Port of Savannah.

Day 3 **Swamp Tour – Lincoln Mall shopping tour**

Day 5 **Key West**

Day 6

Kennedy Space Center

Kennedy Space Center, located on the east coast of Florida, KSC is adjacent to Cape Canaveral Air Force Station (CCAFS) which was established by July, 1962. From the Visitor Complex, guests will view rockets from all eras of space exploration in the Rocket Garden. In addition, walk beneath a massive Saturn V rocket, one of the most powerful ever built. Also guests will have chance to be at the Apollo/Saturn V Center and relive Neil Armstrong's first steps on the moon and experience the thunderous rumble of a rocket lift-off! The tour will continue with two IMAX space movies played on five-story screens – Magnificent Desolation, they are: “Walking on the Moon 3D” and “Space Station 3D”, which takes you on a virtual trip to the International Space Station. Later, guests will board a full-size Space Shuttle mock-up and strap in for a virtual launch into space on the Shuttle Launch Experience. Orbit the earth in this awesome simulation replicating the sights, sounds and feelings of an authentic shuttle launch.

Day 7

St. Augustine, Florida
