Itinerary

Day 1: Olympia, WA – Portland

Visit Olympia, the capital city of the State of Washington, to see **the State House**. Travel north to Columbia River Gorge in 40 miles to the east of Portland. The Columbia River is the 4th largest river by volume in the nation, flows inside the Rocky Mountains. It coves and runs for 1000 miles along the border of two states, Oregon and Washington. The magnificent view of the valley includes **Multnomah**, a famous 620 feet falls. Our next stop is to see **salmon fish migration**. Ballard locks fish ladder (21 steps) is the biggest fish ladder among Northwestern America. Visitors will see the amazing moment of life. Next stop is Portland where we will visit **the International Rose Test Garden**, which was built in 1917 for the worldwide rose experiment. You can always see new types of roses growing here.

Later we will visit The **Pittock Mansion**, it is in the West Hills of Portland, Oregon is a beautiful mansion located on a scenic hilltop overlooking the city. Originally built for publisher Henry Pittock, this estate is now open to the public for touring.

Day 2: Crater Lake National Park(Summer)/ Portland In-depth City Tour (Winter)

Crater Lake National Park (Summer: Mid of April - October)

After breakfast, we will travel to Crater Lake National Park. Upon arrival, we will see the deepest lake in the United States and enjoy the beautiful scenery. The lake was formed after the collapse of mount mazama - an ancient volcano that erupted approximately 7,700 years ago, the length of lake is 6 miles and width is 4 miles with a depth of 1932 feet.

Portland In-depth City Tour (Winter: October – Mid of April)

After breakfast, we'll go to **Pioneer Courthouse Square**, also known as Portland's living room, is a public space occupying a full 40,000-square-foot city block in the center of downtown Portland. We will visit Japanese American Historical Plaza, we will see the Steel Bridge, Hawthorne Bridge. And later we will visit RoseQuarter(outside visit).

The Grotto is a Catholic shrine in Portland is in a cave on a cliff. The whole area takes up about 62 acres and features several thousand feet of trails, making this a peaceful place for a reflective walk.

Day 3: Woodburn Outlets Shopping – Seattle

Woodburn is the largest outlets in Oregon with more than 100 named brands. Tips: Oregon State is free of sales tax! Enjoy shopping! Enjoy saving! Later we will return to your departure locations.

Back to Chinatown Seattle after the tour.
